
The Organisation undertakes so far as reasonably practicable:-

- to ensure the safe handling, storage, use and transport of articles and substances.
- to provide such information, instruction, training and supervision as is necessary to ensure the health and safety of all persons at work.
- to maintain all places of work that are in a condition that is safe and without risks to health.
- to provide a working environment for persons at work that is safe and without risks to health, including adequate arrangements for employees' welfare.
- to define the responsibilities for health and safety for all persons at work.
- to promote joint consultation and employee involvement in health and safety at work.
- to identify any hazards that may exist, and bring these hazards together with necessary precautions to the attention of persons at work.
- to record and investigate accidents and the causes of occupational ill-health.

To support this commitment, the company's Health and Safety management system shall comply with the requirements of the **British Standard BS OHSAS 18001:2007**.

As part of continual improvement, the health and safety performance of the business is reviewed and audited on a regular basis and discussed by top level management where objectives and targets for continual improvement are set.
